# Eastern Oregon University Methodology Summary August 16, 2016

## Methodology:

### **Identifying High School Program Students**

Any student with a fee rate code of 'HIGH' was counted as a High School Program student

#### **Associating Students to Schools**

In identifying students' high school of origin we searched, in order:

- 1. High School code reported to the state for the student in the last term in which the student took a class.
- 2.Latest Campus Code for the student in 2015-2016 (entered in SAAADMS' curriculum tab)
- 3.Latest High School in records (entered in the SOAHSCH in Banner)
- 4. School code of the last dual-credit course for which the student registered

This School of origin was used to assign headcounts and credit hours to High School campuses.

#### Assignment of Credits & Headcounts to Dual Credit, Credit by Proficience, and Other categories:

#### **Dual Credit Courses**

Dual credit courses are those which feature a 'DC' attribute (Visible in Banner under the SSADETL screen).

#### **Credit by Proficiency Courses**

Sections lacking the DC attribute, which are associated with a High School campus, we identified as Credit by Proficiency courses.

#### **Other Courses**

Sections which are neither associated with a high school campus nor tagged with the DC attribute, yet are attended by a student with a 'HIGH' fee rate code, are assigned to the "Other" category. These may include, among others, courses the student attended on an EOU campus (Main Campus or one of the sattelites ) or EOU courses which the student attended online.

#### **Assigning Credit Hours and Headcount**

Credit hours are counted toward the total credit hours of that course's type for the school to which the attending student is associated.

Students who have registered for at least one course of a particular type are counted toward that category's heacount for the school to which the student is associated.

#### **Comparing Previous Data:**

Be aware that figures reported prior to the 2014-15 year didn't distinguish this third, "Other" category. The change in metric will need to be taken into account in comparing the other two categories between previous years.

## Notes on Ethnicity Data:

## Available Data

Ethnicity data continues to be a little thin, lacking race/ethnicity data for about 28% of high school students.

### **Pacific Islander and Asian categories**

We are now tracking Asian and Pacific Islader populations separately. For the historical tables we've combined these numbers for comparison with previous years. In reports for the current year Asian and Pacific Islander numbers are separated.






High School Program Totals over Time August 26, 2015






Eastern Oregon University Average Race/Ethnicity and Gender August 16, 2016




