Grade 5

- Review and sign initial Eastern Promise Academic Momentum Compact
(School district staff, student, parent)
- Complete a college/career curriculum unit
(8+ weeks)
- Participate in a **College Visitation Program** to Eastern Oregon University or another 4 year university.
- Participate in a college/career week in your school.
- Complete 5th Grade Academic Momentum **Personal Development Plan**.
(If possible submit to Google Documents).

Grade 6

- Review and sign Eastern Promise Academic Momentum Compact
- Complete college/career curriculum unit
(8+ weeks) culminating with a **research project on 3 colleges or careers** of their choice that address their current career interest.
- Participate in a **school district field trip to a local business or** gather information regarding **career opportunities and educational requirements** through a career day or career week.
- **Revise/Update Academic Momentum Personal Development Plan** and submit to Google Documents.

Grade 7

- Review and sign Eastern Promise Academic Momentum Compact
- Create official Plan and Profile as required by Oregon Department of Education
- Complete college/career curriculum unit
(8+ weeks)
- Participate in a **College Visitation Program** to Blue Mountain Community College/Treasure Valley Community College or another trade school.
- **Revise/Update Academic Momentum Personal Development Plan** and submit to Google Documents.

Grade 8

- Review and sign Eastern Promise Academic Momentum Compact
- Complete a college/career curriculum unit emphasizing "**Transition to High School**"
(8+ weeks)
- Participate in **School District Career Day** or a field trip to a **Career Fair**
- **Revise/Update Academic Momentum Personal Development Plan** and submit to Google Documents.
